# **Pre-surgical Orientation**

#### **Prior to Surgery**

Your doctor will provide pre-surgical instructions. In addition, a nurse from the Ambulatory Surgery Center will contact you by phone prior to surgery to review instructions so that you and your child are prepared.

#### **Day of Surgery**

- Be sure to arrive at the requested time prior to the procedure.
- Remember to bring your insurance card and photo identification. If you have a prescription, please bring that, too.
- Please register at the front desk upon arrival.
- You will be able to remain with your child in the pre-surgical area, until it is time for the surgery to begin.

# While You Wait

A comfortable waiting area is provided for families while the child is in surgery. Once the procedure is concluded, your child's surgeon will be available to provide you with an update and discuss the timeframe for you to return home. Home care and follow-up instructions will also be provided.

# **Billing Information**
